Directions

From the North via Turnpike or I-75

Take the **turnpike SOUTH** to **836 EAST**. Take this to **826 SOUTH**. Just past the Bird Road exit, 826 South will split. Stay **RIGHT** toward Kendall. Get off at the first exit, **Miller Road/SW 56 St**. Make a left at the bottom of the ramp and head east on Miller. Proceed until it ends at San Amaro Drive. Take a **Left onto San Amaro**. The School of Law is a half block down on the right.

I-95 Directions from the North

Take **I-95 South**. Stay in the middle lane as there are exits on both sides. I-95 turns into **US1/South Dixie Hwy**. Continue south on US1 for about 4.5 miles. At **Stanford Drive** make a **RIGHT**, then an immediate **LEFT** onto Ponce de Leon Blve. At San Amaro Dr (third light), go **RIGHT**. Follow San Amaro, pass through the first light at Miller Rd, then take the next right into the Law School parking lot. Law School on the left.

From Miami International Airport

As you exit the airport terminal, take the exit which reads South/LeJeune/836 West/Coral Gables. Stay on LeJeune Rd Southbound for several miles. At US1, make a **RIGHT**. Stay on US1 for about a mile. At **Stanford Drive** make a **RIGHT**, then an immediate **LEFT** onto Ponce de Leon Blve. At San Amaro Dr (third light), go **RIGHT**. Follow San Amaro, pass through the first light at Miller Rd, then take the next right into the Law School parking lot. Law School on the left.
